

• Since 2019 the ministry has given nearly \$10,000 to 19 qualified recipients to pursue individualized courses of study to strengthen their church music skills to serve their parishes. Six of these individuals were under the age of 18.

Consultation Outreach has begun by the Church Music Development Team to identify the specific music education needs of our Metropolis parishes. This enables us to create and plan workshops, seminars, and YouTube videos that serve not only individual parishes but to plan regional events as well.

- Constant Contact also allows us to streamline the communication and registration process for in-person and online workshops, assisting local parishes in easily setting up events.
- Our Zoom platform has allowed us to hold our required twice yearly Plenary Information and Planning Meetings in a format that allows full access and participation to every steward and interested church musician. Zoom also enables us to present our on-line programs as well.
